## WALL Gives Back with Scholarship Funds

Dear Members



The Board of Directors of WALL and representatives of Wesleyan College have signed an agreement establishing a WALL Scholarship for a rising senior.

The scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, is “need-based” and the recipient will be selected by the Financial Aid Office. The first scholarship will be awarded this April and the money may be used for tuition, room and board, books or other college-related expenses. This will be an annual scholarship, however, the WALL Finance Committee, comprising the Board of Directors, and the College Treasurer, will determine when sufficient funds are available in the WALL bank account held by Wesleyan College.



The slate of candidates for office will be announced in the May newsletter and nominations from the floor also will be accepted. Attendees will be able to register for Fall Courses at the meeting

Volunteers are needed for the Curriculum Committee. The committee could use a few new members to assist in planning the curriculum for upcoming semesters. 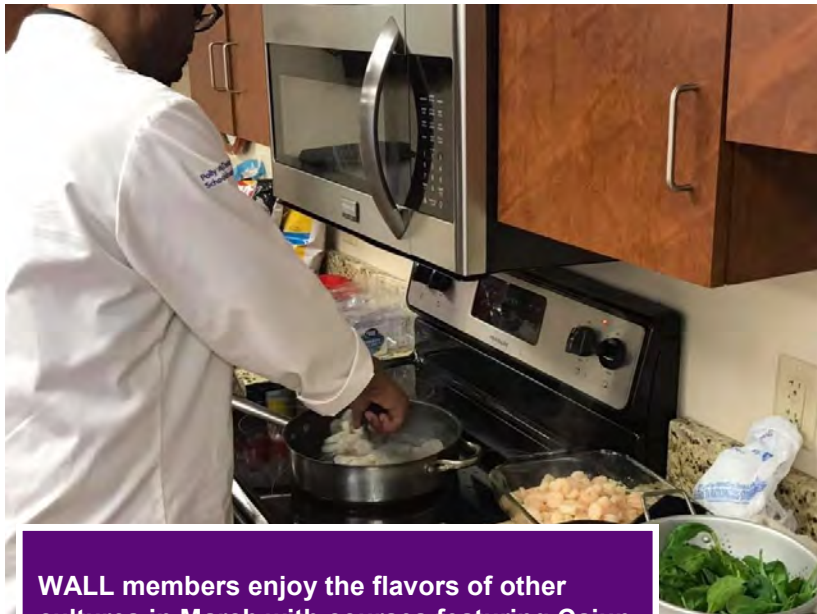
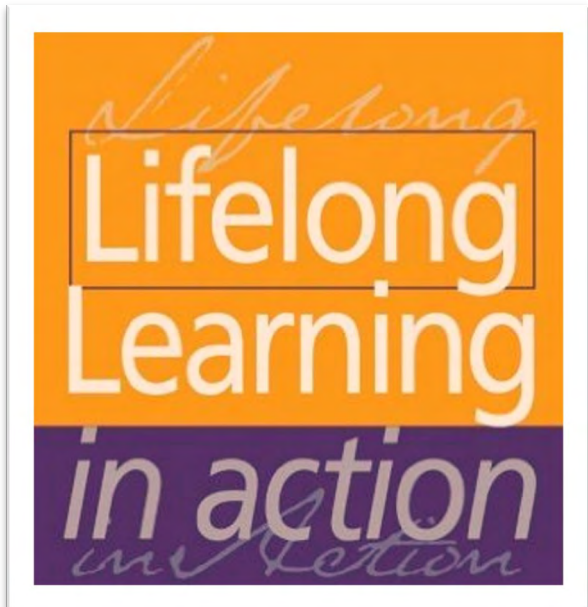

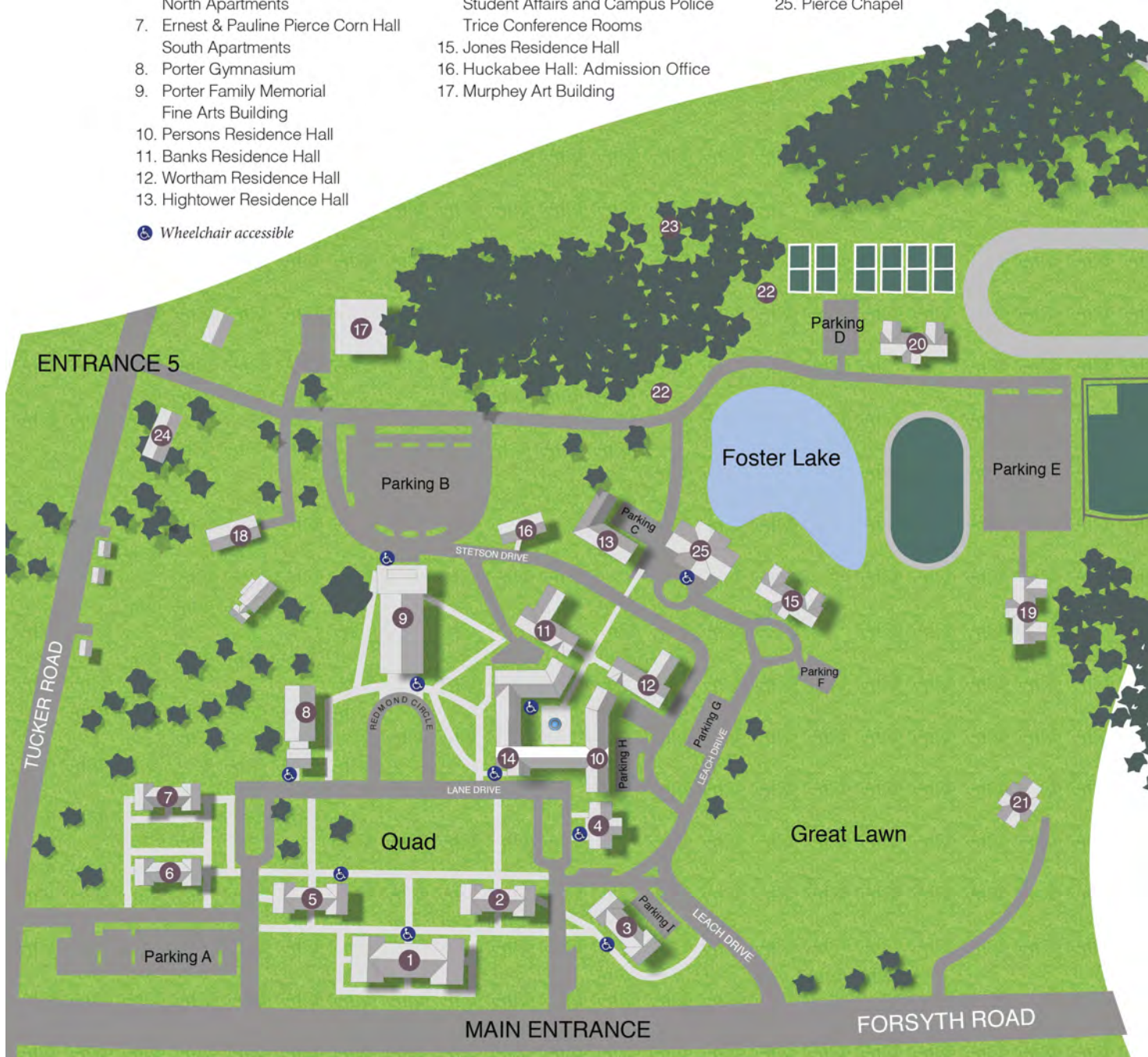
