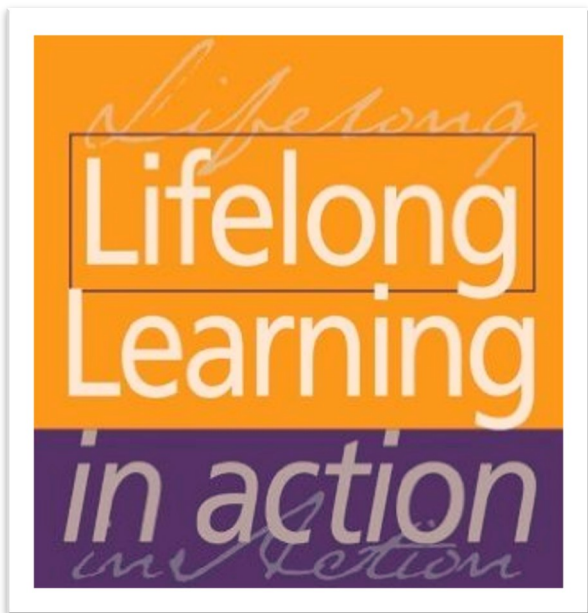

Wesleyan College offers so much to our WALL members and to the community at large. Many events on campus are open to the public (most are free of charge).

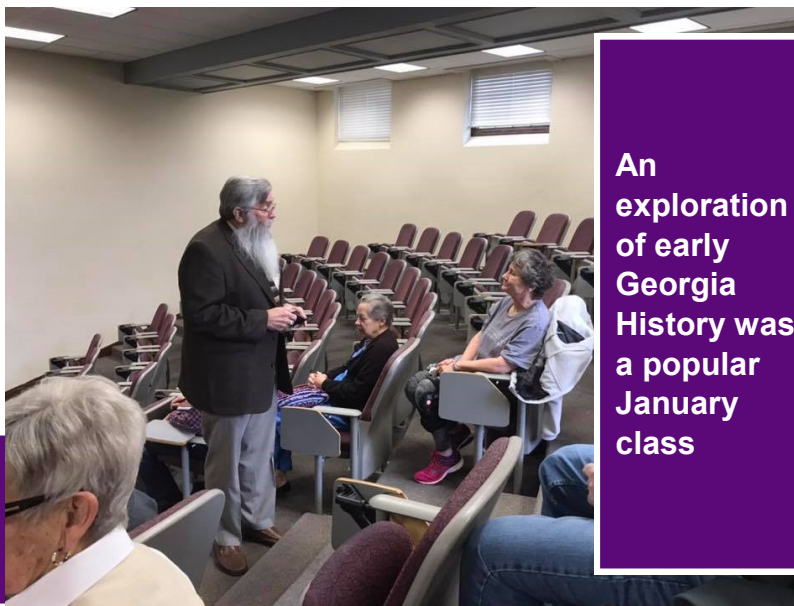

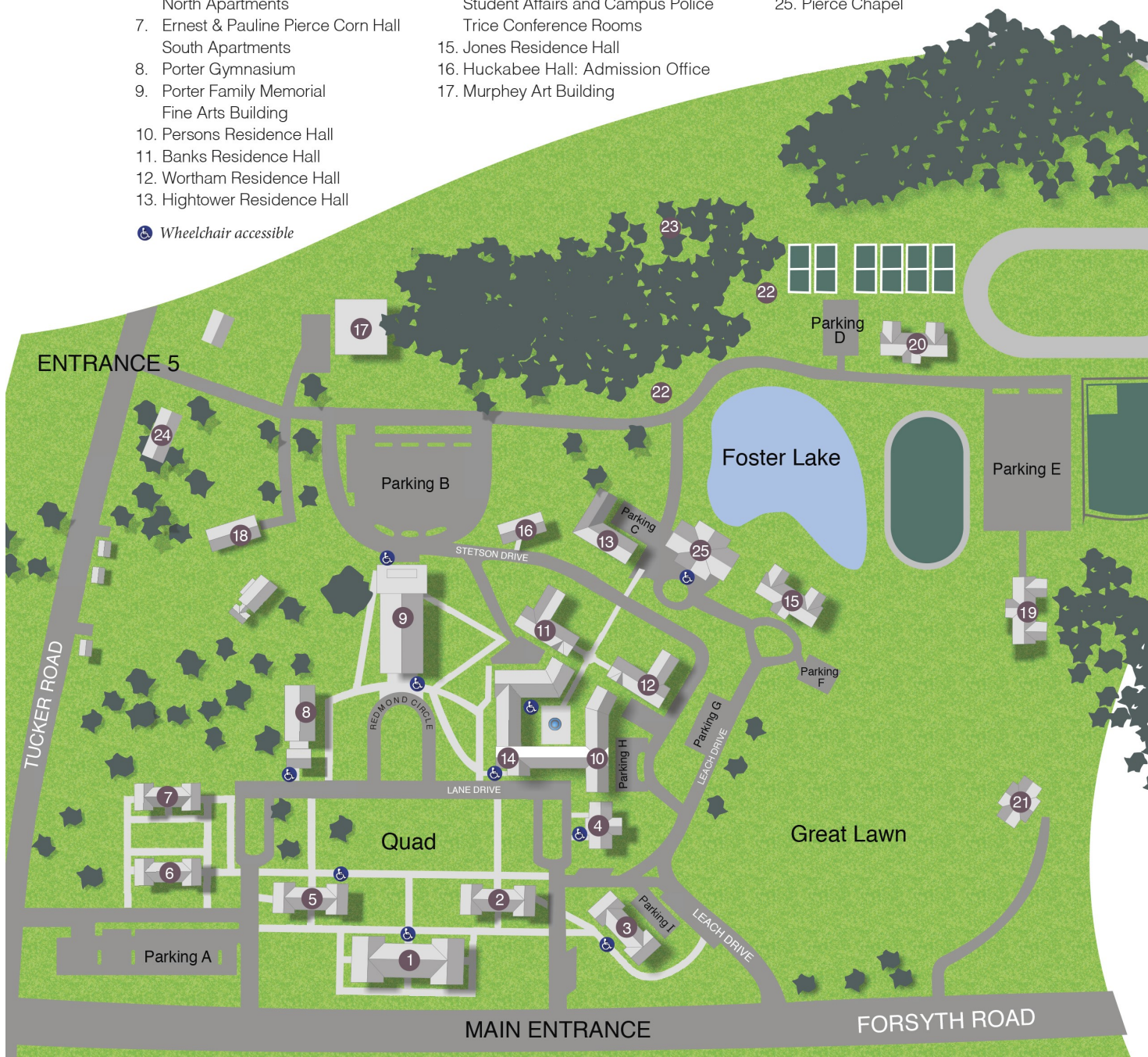
