

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION FOR SUMMER 2011

Students attending summer school at Wesleyan College may be eligible to receive state and federal aid. Please be advised that summer school is the end of the 2010-2011 academic year.

To be considered for federal and state financial aid, you must have a 2010-2011 FAFSA on file. All annual limits apply. Students who have received maximum federal awards during the fall and spring term will have no available funds for summer study. Students who advance a grade level may gain additional edibility. All federal requirements apply. **Please note: You must file a FAFSA before June 30, 2011 to be considered for loans for summer term classes in 2011.**

To be considered for state financial aid, you must also have a **Georgia Scholarship/Grant Application (GSFAPPS)** on file.

Requesting Summer Financial Aid**Eligibility**

- For most programs, you must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours as an undergraduate or 5 credits as a graduate student, admitted to Wesleyan College as a degree-seeking student, and must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress standards.
- If you received any loan funds and your enrollment drops to less than half-time during the summer for any reason, you will be required to repay your entire loan.
- Undergraduate students with a cumulative GPA less than 2.0 may not be eligible.
- **Satisfactory Academic Progress:** If you were awarded summer financial aid and you do not meet Satisfactory Academic Progress standards after your grades have been reported for the 2011 spring semester, your **summer aid will be cancelled**. If your financial aid has credited your tuition account, the aid will be cancelled and the funds returned to your lender. You will need to make alternative plans to pay for your 2011 summer session tuition and repay any aid that is cancelled.

Transient Enrollment

- If you are a Wesleyan student planning to attend another college for the 2011 summer session, you must complete the Summer Financial Aid Request **and** a Consortium Agreement Form.
- If you are a student from another college planning to attend Wesleyan College for the 2011 summer session, you must contact your school's financial aid office to apply for financial aid assistance. Wesleyan cannot award you financial aid.

Study Abroad

- If you will be studying abroad with a direct exchange or other study abroad program, please be sure to provide the Financial Aid Office with an itemized breakdown of your expected expenses. In addition, make sure that you complete the proper study abroad forms available from Karen Huber, Study Abroad Coordinator.

Disbursements

- Your loan funds will be disbursed electronically to your student tuition and fee account in the Business Office provided you are eligible to receive the funds. If the amount of your financial aid exceeds your college charges, a credit balance (refund) check will be generated. The check will be mailed to you by the Business Office 14 days after your funds have posted to your student account. If you are enrolled in more than one session, your funds will not post until you start the session that makes half-time.

Please contact the Financial Aid Office if your enrollment plans change.
