The Findlay Scholars Program provides two scholarships annually to academically superior first-year applicants for admission whose intended major is in the area of Humanities or Social Sciences. Each scholarship recipient receives an annual award, which replaces any previously awarded institutional scholarships. In addition, she is eligible to apply for a \$500 stipend each year to support research conducted during the summer or during the academic year. This program is funded by Cuyler W. Findlay in honor of his wife, Gayle Attaway Findlay, a Wesleyan alumna.

Eligible candidates must possess the following minimum academic credentials: 1200 SAT (Critical Reading and Math) or 27 ACT (Composite Score) and a 3.5 grade point average, or an 1100 SAT (Critical Reading and Math) or 25 ACT (Composite Score) and a 3.75 grade point average. In addition, candidates must demonstrate their interest in research and the ability to engage in research. They will be expected to interview with the Findlay Scholarship Selection Committee during Wesleyan's Scholarship Day, February 2012. *Participating students will be considered for other scholarships in the academic areas of the humanities and social sciences.
