The Margaret A. Pitts Endowed Scholarship for Methodist Students for Fall 2012 will provide an annual scholarship to a first-year applicant or to a graduating student transferring from Andrew College who demonstrates outstanding academic achievement along with a commitment to faith and community service. Each of these scholarship recipients receives an annual award, which replaces any previously awarded institutional scholarships. (Smaller awards may be made to additional students.)

Long affiliated with the Methodist Church, Wesleyan is committed to preparing women grounded in faith and life-long service to others. The Margaret A. Pitts Endowed Scholarship for Methodist Students honors the memory of Margaret Pitts, a devout Methodist who was generous with both her resources and her time to Methodist causes throughout her life, by offering financial aid to Methodist women who have held leadership positions in their churches and schools. This scholarship has been funded through the generous support of the William I. H. and Lula E. Pitts Foundation, which was established by and named for Margaret Pitts' parents.

Eligible candidates must possess the following minimum academic credentials: a 1000 SAT (Critical Reading and Math) or 23 ACT (Composite Score) and a 3.0 cumulative high school or college grade point average. In addition, a student must be an active member of a United Methodist Church and have church and school leadership experience. Students must submit certification of church membership from their pastors and provide one letter of support from their school or a service agency to document community service activities. To retain this scholarship, recipients must maintain a cumulative grade point average at Wesleyan of 2.75 and be an active member of Wesleyan Disciples. They will be expected to interview with the Pitts Scholarship Selection Committee during Wesleyan's Scholarship Day, February 2012. **Interested students must submit this application, as well as all required admission materials, to the Office of Admission no later than January 29, 2012.
